1 MR101 Level 1 NCEA Te Reo Māori

This course is mainly focused on developing beginners' ability to understand spoken Te Reo Māori in familiar contexts and for them to be able to kōrero in a supportive environment. Ākonga/learners who are more literate will be able to extend their skills through learning to write proficiently in Te Reo, and/or Pānui/Reading Comprehension, in preparation for an external exam.

Course Components may include (depending on interest/strengths)

- Whakarongo/Listening Comprehension
- Pānui/Reading Comprehension
- Kōrero/Speaking
- Tuhituhi/Writing
